Gold Coast Airport Marathon (42.195km)

Overall Prize Money

- Total payout **\$73,000**.
- Awarded to first five finishers regardless of times and nationality.

- **Time bonus money** (gun/official time) paid in addition to the overall placegetter prize money (note that amounts are not cumulative).

Sample scenarios:

- If the female race winner runs 2:26:15 they will win \$20,000 + \$8,000 bonus
- If the male second placegetter runs 2:08:20 they will win \$8,000 + \$5,000 bonus
- If the male winner runs 2:09:30 they will win \$20,000 + \$2,000 bonus

Separate Prize Pool for IAAF Oceania Area Marathon Championships

- Possible payout **\$12,000**.
- Athletes competing in the IAAF Oceania Area Marathon Championships are eligible for either the outright placegetter prize money or the below Oceania prize pool (whichever amount is higher). No double dipping. Placegetters will also receive Oceania Championship medals.

- For example:
 - i) If the first three Oceania runners finish 1st, 2nd and 5th overall then only the overall prize money above is paid. No Oceania prize money is paid.
 - ii) If the first three Oceania runners finish 1st, 2nd and 9th overall then these runners would receive \$20,000, \$8,000 and \$1,000 respectively i.e. only 3rd place Oceania prize money paid.

Incentive money for fast times by athletes from all Oceania countries

- Paid in addition to the above outright or Oceania placegetter prize money.
- All IAAF Oceania Marathon Championship competitors are eligible for the fast time incentive money outlined below irrespective of placing.
- Based on gun/official time.
- Note that the bonus money available to the overall top five placegetters and the Oceania incentive money amounts are not cumulative (i.e. each athlete can only win one bonus/fast-time incentive payment and they are entitled to win whichever is the highest amount).

- For example, a New Zealand female athlete who places 7th overall and is the 3rd Oceania finisher in a time of 2:42:17 wins \$2,000 (\$1,000 for 3rd Oceania finisher & \$1,000 for breaking 2:42:30)



ASICS Half Marathon (21.1km)

Overall Prize Money

- Total payout **\$18,000**.
- Awarded to first three finishers regardless of times and nationality.

Overall Place	Men	Women
1	\$6,000	\$6,000
2	\$2,000	\$2,000
3	\$1,000	\$1,000

- \$2,000 bonus if race winner breaks race record
(1:01:16 men and 1:09:00 women)

Note - If more than one athlete breaks the race record time only the race winner will be eligible for the bonus.

Southern Cross University 10km Run

Overall Prize Money

- Total payout **\$4,500**.
- Awarded to first three finishers regardless of times and nationality.

Overall Place	Men	Women
1	\$1,000	\$1,000
2	\$750	\$750
3	\$500	\$500

- \$1,000 bonus if race winner breaks race record
(28:53 men and 32:17 women)

Note - If more than one athlete breaks the race record time only the race winner will be eligible for the bonus.

Wheelchair Marathon

Overall Prize money

- Total payout **\$2,500**.
- Awarded to first three finishes regardless of times and nationality

Overall Place	Men	Women
1	\$550	\$550
2	\$400	\$400
3	\$300	\$300

- \$500 bonus if race winner break race record
(1:30:18 men and 1:43:45 women)
- \$250 bonus for times faster than 1:50:00 (men) or 2:10:00 (women)

Footnote to the Prize & Incentive Money Schedule

1. Currency

All prize and bonus/incentive money amounts are in Australian Dollars (AUD).

2. Tax

All prize money and bonuses may be subject to a deduction of Australian Government withholding tax for those who are not Australian residents.

3. Dead heats

In the event that there is a dead heat for any prize money winning place (i.e. a dead heat for first, second or third) in the marathon, half marathon or 10km then the relevant prize money shall be combined and then split equally between the competitors. Sample scenarios:

- a. Should two runners dead heat for 1st in the marathon they will each be awarded \$14,000.
- b. Should three runners dead heat for 1st in the marathon they will each be awarded \$11,000.
- c. Should two runners dead heat for 3rd in the half marathon they will each be awarded \$500.
