



Gold Coast Marathon 2020 – BYO Tent Area

- The BYO Tent area is located north of Nind Street in Broadwater Parklands between Nind and North Street.
- Spaces cannot be 'reserved' and the area will be occupied on a 'first in, first served' basis
- There is strictly a <u>1 tent limit</u> per team. Any additional tents may be dismantled by the Event Manager
- Access to <u>install</u> your tent will be anytime Friday 3 July until 5.00pm and Saturday 4 July between 2.00pm to 5.00pm
- IMPORTANT: All tents must be pegged or weighted and left lowered overnight
- You may install a tent in the BYO area for one day (Saturday or Sunday) or the whole weekend
- For tents remaining erected for the entire weekend, you may leave your tent overnight, however you do so at your own risk
- BBQs are not allowed in the space only area and will be removed from the site
- Roads will be closed from 3.30am on Saturday 4 July and Sunday 5 July, and there will be strictly no access for cars.
 If you need to bring items on the morning of, they will need to be hand carried or trollies used. It is therefore suggested that any heavy items be delivered the afternoon before
- No vehicles will be permitted to drive on the grass in the Broadwater Parklands precinct. Limited parking is located at the Bait Shop on the corner of Railway Street and Marine Parade or in surrounding streets. Parking is also available off North Street in the new Broadwater Parklands boat ramp redevelopment
- Please ensure tents are not covering the pedestrian footpaths
- Security will monitor the area, however whilst all care is taken, GCM shall take no responsibility for any loss or damage that may occur
- **IMPORTANT** If you try to erect your tent before the designated access times, it will be dismantled by the Event Manager, regardless of whether you have departed the site or not. Likewise, if tents are erected outside the designated area, they will be dismantled by the Event Manager
- Once the BYO tent area has been deemed 'full' by the Event Manager no further tents will not be allowed in the BYO section
- For tent pack down, surrounding roads will reopen at approximately 11:30am on Saturday 4 July and approximately 2.30pm Sunday 5 July. The same conditions will apply as set up where cars will not be allowed on the grass as well as limited parking being available
- There will be an event crew member onsite to assist with where you can set up your tent or if you have any questions
