Dear Resident or Business Owner,

As part of the ASICS Gold Coast Marathon weekend, your area will form part of the official course on **both Saturday 4 July and Sunday 5 July 2026**. To ensure a safe and successful event, a number of road closures and access changes will be in place in **Main Beach** and surrounding areas.

Please take a moment to review the information below and plan ahead to minimise disruption.

Temporary Road Closures: Saturday 4 July 2026

Southport	Closed	Open
Southport Bridge - FULL CLOSURE Gold Coast Hwy: Ada Bell Way to Tedder Ave	8:45am	10:15am

Note:

Fully closed from 8:45am to 10:15am

- Full access to Seaworld Drive is maintained via Tedder Avenue or Main Beach Parade from the south.
- Staff and guests are advised to access Seaworld Drive via Chevron Island or Isle of Capri during this time.

Important

Please note: **All vehicles must be removed from the course area by 3:30 AM sharp each day.**

Any vehicles remaining on closed roads after this time **will be towed at the owner's expense** to ensure the course is clear and safe for participants.

Planning Ahead

To help minimise inconvenience on the day:

- Move vehicles out of affected areas before road closures begin
- Let your household, customers, or staff know in advance
- Consider alternate travel routes and parking locations until roads reopen

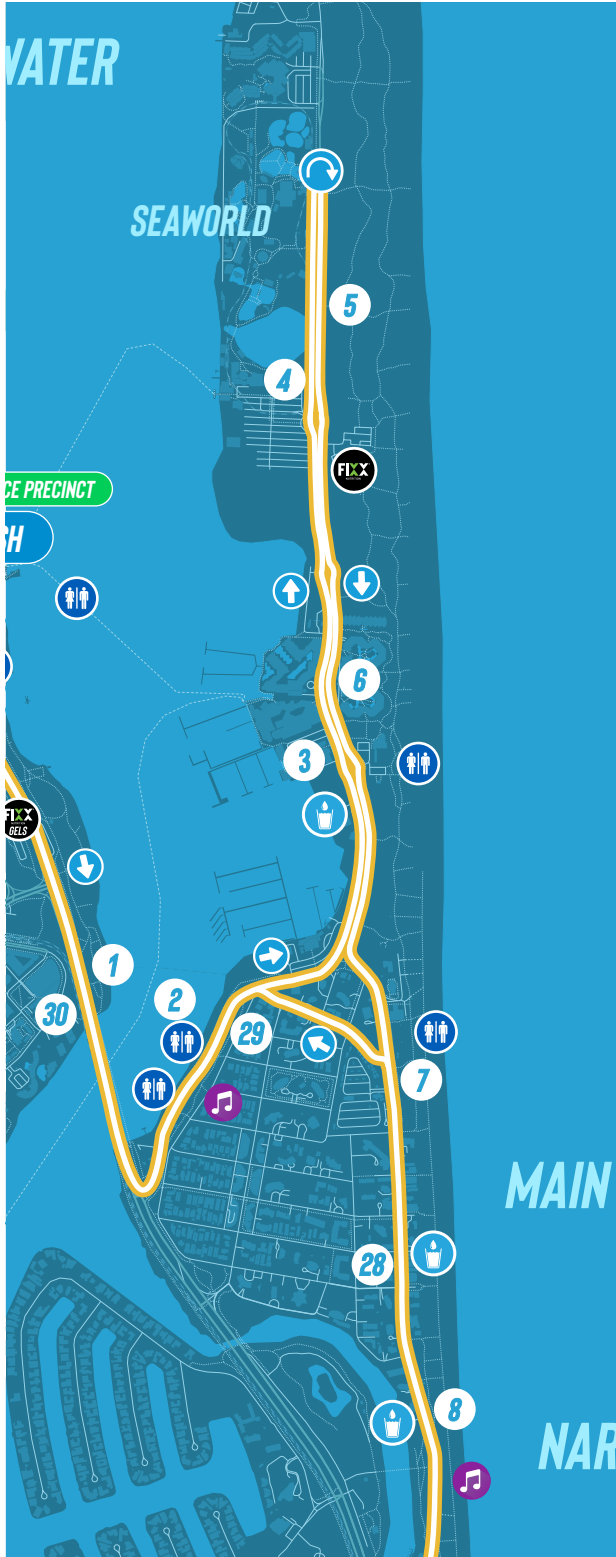

Additional Seaworld Drive Access Info:

- Limited vehicle access may be permitted via Stafford Avenue until approximately 4am - 5:45am, after which a full closure in both directions will be enforced.
- A full closure in both directions will be enforced from 5:45am – 7:35am
- Northbound lanes will reopen from approximately 7:35am, with access via Stafford Avenue only.
- From approximately 8:30am to 11:00am, access via Stafford Avenue will be significantly impacted due to continuous runner flow
- Until 11:45am, all access to Seaworld Drive must be via Stafford Avenue. Stafford Avenue can be accessed off Mountbatten Ave, Lennie Avenue and Hughes Avenue (via Tedder Avenue)
- Normal traffic conditions will progressively resume after 11:45am

Entertainment and Ambient Noise

As part of the event atmosphere, several entertainment stations will be set up along the course, featuring live music, speakers, and announcers to support and motivate the runners.

While we strive to keep sound levels considerate, you may notice some increased ambient noise in the morning hours of the event.

Boat Ramp Access

Access to boat ramps will be restricted while road closures are in effect. Please refer to the event website and local signage for full details to assist with planning.
