Dear Resident or Business Owner,

Surfers Paradise will play an exciting role in the ASICS Gold Coast Marathon on Sunday 5 July 2026. The event will bring thousands of visitors and participants to our city and showcase the beauty of the Gold Coast – including our world-famous beachfront!

To ensure the safety of participants and the public, a number of temporary road closures will be in place throughout Sunday morning. Please take a moment to review the details below and plan ahead to minimise disruption.

#### Temporary Road Closures Sunday 5 July 2026

Clifford St: Esplanade to Surfers Paradise Blvd	3:30am	11:30am
Surfers Paradise Blvd: Clifford St to Gold Coast Highway	3:30am	11:30am
Gold Coast Highway: Surfers Paradise Blvd to Fern St	3:30am	11:30am
Northcliffe Tce: Fern St to Clifford St	3:30am	11:30am
Fern St: Gold Coast Highway to Old Burleigh Rd	3:30am	11:30am
Old Burleigh Rd: Fern St to First Ave	3:30am	11:00am

#### Important

Any vehicles remaining on closed roads after this time will be towed at the owner's expense to ensure the course is clear and safe for participants.

Residents and businesses located between Surfers Paradise Boulevard and the coastline, from Clifford Street through to Fern St, will be unable to access or use vehicles between 3:30 AM and 11:30 AM. During this time, the area will be fully closed to traffic and vehicle movements will not be permitted. Limited and controlled access will only be granted once roads begin reopening.

#### Planning Ahead

To reduce disruption:

- Relocate any vehicles the night before if you'll need them on Sunday morning
- Inform staff, visitors, and customers of the closures
- Allow additional travel time and plan alternate access routes
